DEERE 644K versus DEERE 624K Owning and Operating COST Based on 10 years/8000 operating hours

- Purchase price difference \$30,000
- Fuel economy difference (1,5GPH) \$42,000
- Maintenance difference \$1.0/hour (fluids, warranty cost, tires) \$8,000
 TOTAL \$80,000

The cost difference of owning and operating ONE SIZE LARGER loader is on average \$10/hour

 - 202,000 lb., 700 hp Cummins and 24' moldboard
