MiDEAL

- MiDEAL Extended Purchasing Program
 - Established in 1984
 - Open to local units of government, schools, universities, authorities, non-profit hospitals
 - Allows members to make purchases from state contracts at the same terms, conditions, pricing

- Saves hard and soft costs associated with competitive bidding
- Over 1050 members



Road Salt Highlights

- Road salt contracts heavily used by MiDEAL members
 - Over 400 members participated in this year's bid
 - Prequalification contracts good through August 31, 2016 plus 2 one year options
 - Pricing bid out yearly
- Benefits
 - Quantity is guaranteed
 - All vendors required to keep 30% additional supply to ensure adequate supply in the event of harsh winter

ENABLING

 Only required to accept 70% of seasonal backup commitment



Process

- MiDEAL members enter requirements into an online application
 - Username and password are provided
- Requirements are entered by drop point and bid out by county
- Quantities are firm commitments
 - Orders may not be cancelled, regardless of final price
 - Person placing order presumed to have authority to do so



2015/2016 Winter Season

- Bid posted 2 weeks earlier (4/30) and evaluation time compressed
- New contracts for the 2015/2016 winter season awarded (6/11)
- Early Fill awards: Awarded vendor for each location will contact entity about delivery in Sept/Oct.
 - Delivered in one lump sum
- Seasonal back-up: Contact the vendor after November 1.

- Requests must be in 50 ton increments
- Must be taken in total by August and/or stored by vendor for additional month for extra fee
