Intersection Description

- High peaking based on large traffic generators
- Very high turn movements
- Very high left turn movements.
- High speed roadway combined with vertical curve (hill) from east.
- Poor alignment and Geometry of intersection.
- Change in speed limit at city limits.

Crash Analysis

- 30 crashes at this intersection
- Four crashes resulting in severe injuries resulting in 5 A injuries (incapacitating)
- 12 Crashes were Angle Crashes
- 11 of the 12 involved drivers that stopped and then proceeded.
- 5 of the crashes were left turn related for the east/west bound directions.

Options

- Do nothing
- Install traffic signal
- Reconstruct intersection with proper turn lanes w/ ALL WAY STOP
- Build a roundabout

• Preliminary engineering- Make sure it is feasable
