

Double Jeopardy

Legal protection afforded to a Road Commission while performing its governmental function



What is Governmental Immunity?



Authority that a governmental agency must have over a highway in order to have legal liability for its repair and maintenance



What is a second of the second



Bridges, sidewalks, trailways, crosswalks and culverts are included in its statutory definition while alleys, trees and utility poles are not



What is the definition of 'Highway'?



The part of the highway for which a Road Commission can be held legally liable



What is the improved portion of the highway designed for vehicular travel?



Term that refers to the expiration of time, after which a Road Commission can no longer be sued



What is the Statute of Limitations?



Clause contained in a contract in which the contractor agrees to protect the Road **Commission from** liability



What is a Hold Harmless / Indemnification Clause?



A Certificate of Insurance supplied by a contractor for a project should identify the Road Commission as this



What is an Additional Insured?



Term used to describe a Road Commission's activities to preserve evidence ASAP after serious accidents

What is Retaliation?



Act that protects an employee who reports or is about to report that his employer is in violation of the law

What is Uniformity?



Warning sign intended for use in advance of a bridge or culvert having a clear two-way roadway width of 17 to 19 feet



What is a "Narrow Bridge" sign?



A "turn" warning sign is intended for use when the recommended speed for the turn is equal to or less than this speed



What is 30 mph?



The MMUTCD is not a substitute for this when making a decision for the installation of a traffic control device



What is "Engineering Judgment"?



Law that allows Road Commission vehicles to ignore certain parts of the Motor Vehicle Code while they are actively engaged in roadway maintenance



What is the Emergency Vehicle Statute?



Legal premise which states that a Road Commission is not liable for accidents caused by ice or snow covered roadways

What is the Natural Accumulation Doctrine?



Doctrine by which the actions of parties to a lawsuit are weighed, often on a percentage basis



What is Comparative Negligence?



Term meaning that plaintiff's injuries and damages were a direct result of defendant's negligent conduct

What is Proximate Cause?



The legal standard for a jury verdict in a criminal trial is "beyond a reasonable doubt". The legal standard for a civil trial is this



What is "preponderance of the evidence"?



Conduct so reckless as to demonstrate a substantial lack of concern for whether an injury results

What is Gross Negligence?



Monetary "Cap" applicable to jury verdicts against Road Commissions?

What is "None"?



The result when a Road Commission fails to file an Answer to a lawsuit within the time frame specified by the Court



What is a Default?



The Evens vs. Shiawassee CRC MSC decision in 2000 affirmed that there can be legal liability for Road Commissions relative to traffic control devices



What is 'False'?



The Hanson vs. Mecosta CRC MSC decision in 2002 eliminated legal liability for **Road Commissions** relative to defective design



What is 'True'??



The Grimes vs. MDOT MSC decision in 2006 affirmed that there can be legal liability for Road Commissions relative to shoulder drop-offs



What is 'False'??



The Regan/Zelanko vs. Washtenaw CRC MSC decision in 2004 affirmed that sweepers, mowers and the like "fit" under the Motor Vehicle Exception to governmental immunity



What is 'True'??



Year in which the Michigan County Road Commission Self-**Insurance Pool** commenced operations



What is 1984?



Number of days an injured person is given to notify a Road Commission of his or her intent to sue under the highway exception to governmental immunity



What is 120 days?



Number of days after which it is "conclusively presumed" that a Road **Commission has** knowledge of a highway defect

What is 30 days?



Pursuant to the State trunkline maintenance agreement, the number of days allowed for a Road Commission to forward a claim relative to a State trunkline highway to the Asst. Atty. General's office
