#### PREMISE

- MDOT Local Agency Program's role
  - Act as agent for FHWA
  - Implement and pass on federal requirements to local agencies, so that local agency's federal aid is not jeopardized

# HMA Acceptance (12SP 501 J-02)



# HMA Acceptance (12SP 501 J-02)

Process started on Jan 25, 2011



- Replaces existing FUSP 12SP 501J
- Intended for use with both Marshall mixes and Superpave.
- Incorporates use of either Direct Density or the Roller Method

# HMA Acceptance (12SP 501 J-02) Key Changes:

- Roller Method (if used) must be DOCUMENTED (pg 7 of 7)
- All HMA Samplers must be "Qualified."
- All HMA Testors must be "Certified."
- Testing Labs must be AMRL or MDOT qualified.
  - Tests complete w/in 14 days (< 3500 Tons)</li>
  - Tests complete w/in 7 days (> 3500 Tons)

# HMA Acceptance (12SP 501 J-02) Key Changes:

- VI up to 500 Tons per Project.
- Penalty per Parameter out of spec, range from 10% to 50% or removal/replacement per Engineer.
- Parameters are: 1. % AC Binder Content
  - 2. % Passing Sieve
  - 3. % Crushed Particle Content
- Method of Sampling to be determined by Engineer at Pre-Con per SP.

- 2. Tree Removal yesterday's LAP presentation
- 3. .XML Files with Estimator as "LAPS"
  - Use MERL version 5.2.8, dated 02/02/2015
- 4. MDOT restricted use of FTP sites.
- 5. Funding
- 6. Completion Dates
- 7. Mobilization = 10 %
- 8. If RR in Work Zone = Require DSTR
- 9. Major Urban Arterial = NHS standards

# 2016-17 Safety Program Update



- Final Scoring Meeting for 2016 has taken place Local Agencies should be notified within the next couple weeks.
- Call Letter for 2017 to follow quickly intend to move Safety Call so submittals can be prepared outside of Construction Season based on survey (will take time).

Applications due May 4, 2015

Refer to MDOT Scoping Manual, Chapter 5, to assist in bridge application scoping and fix selection

## Bridge Fund Application Hints

Use the Electronic Application Submittal Option

Optional, but preferred

Link is posted on the Bridge Program page of the LAP website

Before submitting, convert files to Adobe pdf format.

Scanned files are too large and may or may not pass through various servers and firewalls

## Bridge Program Update

#### 2014 Bridge Applications

334 Bridge Applications Received – 15% increase

\$235 million in applications ~ \$48 million in funding

90 Projects selected for FY 2017 Construction

"Mix of Fixes" – 50% Replacement – 50% Rehab/PM

27% of total \$ selected are Rehab/PM

#### Federal Land Access Program

Call for Projects issued in November 2014
Proposed projects with access to federal facility

**Examples** 

Federal Forest Highway

National park or lakeshore

Multi-year call, FY 2015 through FY 2018

Estimated \$1.6 million funds available per fiscal year

# Email Applications before 02/13/15, to EFL.planning@dot.gov

#### For Michigan projects, generally

- Construction cost estimate range \$500,000 to \$750,000
- Requires at least 20% local match
- Construction only, generally not PE, CE, ROW, etc.
- Project can be proposed in phases

# Fund Obligation Status

Obligation thermometer and status reports

Posted monthly on LAP website

FY 2015 Obligation Reports

(www.michigan.gov/mdotlap)

Congress funded the program through May 2015

# Force Account Program

Currently working on draft of updated guidance document

Expect to complete working draft in mid February

Will forward draft to CRA for comment

provide adequate inspection during construction

keep construction records (IDR's, test results, certifications)

#### QUALITY OF SUBMITTALS

- → Local Agency is responsible for QC / QA of plans, special provisions, construction cost estimates, permits, SHPO letter
- → Recent submittals have been incomplete, scattered
- → Don't submit an incomplete package just to meet a deadline
- → Address the permit requirements
- → Sometimes obvious that minimal QC was completed
- → Don't submit ANYTHING until you have EVERYTHING

#### SECTION 106 REVIEWS

- Contact the area Native American Tribal Governments
- Contact is required as part of Section 106
- Contact is NOT MADE by SHPO, and NOT included in the SHPO letter
- Link to Tribal Government contact information is on LAP website

#### PROGRESS CLAUSES

Low bidder prepares Form 1130, "Progress Schedule"

After contract award, schedule the Preconstruction meetings

#### **PERMITS**

- →Address all the permit requirements
  - →Serious consequences, including loss of federal aid
- →Permits are required for ALL work in trunkline right of way
  - →Construction tasks
  - →Construction signs



#### TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND LIGHTING

- → Work includes the
  - → Street Lighting
  - → Signal head(s)
  - → Controllers
  - $\rightarrow$  Poles, span wires
  - → Loop detectors
  - → Address all the permit requirements
  - → Serious consequences, including loss of federal aid

#### PAY ITEMS

Mobilization 10% max

Issues with \_\_\_\_\_, Modified

Station Grading, Modified Machine Grading Modified

SP needs to include major items of work, and accurate estimated quantities (earth excavation, subgrade undercut, etc)

CAUTION – for addenda, also need to update the estimated quantities

RECENT BID EXPERIENCE - SP had "placeholder / inaccurate quantities"
