

REVISITING TRANSPORTATION ASSET MANAGEMENT PLAN REQUIREMENTS UNDER PA 325 OF 2018

Event Description

It's been 8 years since Public Act 325 of 2018 was enacted, requiring local road agencies with 100 or more certified road miles to complete an asset management plan for roads and bridges that it owns on a three-year cycle. The Transportation Asset Management Council (TAMC) is responsible for ensuring the timely submittal of plans and is required to review and approve all plans.

This web meeting will give local agencies a chance to speak firsthand with the people from TAMC who process and review asset management plans. Topics covered during this meeting include:

- The who, what, when, and why of PA 325 asset management plan requirements.
- The submittal and review/acceptance process.
- Local agency examples
- Overview of common missed areas that may result in a plan being rejected.
- How do I show progress toward my goal in the Investment Reporting Tool self-assessment?
- What happens if my plan is late?
